

Exam:

- Final exam will be a **written exam**, in the E-Test system content:
 - **Physiology** -1/3 part Physiology I, 2/3 part Physiology II;
 - **Pathophysiology** – 1/3 Pathophysiology I, 2/3 Pathophysiology II.
- After **two (or five) failed written exams oral exam (C exam) may be chosen instead of written exam**. Oral C exam will be on the last week of the exam period, in attendance.

Exam materials:

- full material of the semester I-II (images included);
- question types: simple choice, true/false, image task, definitions, multiple choice.

Course Requirements:**Attendance on Lectures:**

- Regular attendance is expected on all lectures.
- Attendance sheet will be taken throughout the semester. You have to sign the attendance sheet on every lecture.
- You will not be able to attend the exam and complete the subject if you are absent from more than 15% of the classes unjustified or more than 30% of the classes justified.

No Progress Exams will be in Semester Period.**Condition of Signature:**

- Regular attendance as stated above.

Extra points to final exam:

If all of the following conditions are met on Physiology II. and Pathophysiology II. lectures during the semester, an extra 10% may be added to Physiology II. and Pathophysiology II. final exam results:

- activity during lectures;
- 80% of quizzes are above 80%;
- a 5-minute oral presentation from one of the lectures.

Important notes:
