



Dear Student,

Please let me inform you of the instructions with reference to Decree 14/2020. Rector's and Chancellor's Joint Instruction (hereinafter: Rector's Instruction) about the visits of the institutions and the hygiene procedure to be applied during epidemiological preparedness, in force from 1 September 2020.

The University of Pécs takes special care to prevent the spread of the coronavirus pandemic, which allows us all to contribute individually to slowing down the spread of the epidemic. This endeavor requires all of us, among other things, to adhere to the following standards, which express our cooperation:

1./ In accordance with the provisions of Article 6 Section (1) of the Rector's Instruction, I request that you **fill in the online risk filter questionnaire and follow its instructions in order to reduce the risks.**

2./ Pursuant to Article 6 Section (3) of the Rector's Instruction:
The student participating in the international trainings will receive a phone call from the PTE Hotline operated by the University in case of a single "yes" answer to the questions asked in the questionnaire.

3./ It is a high priority that according to the provisions of Article 6 Section (5) of the Rector's Instruction, **if any changes occur** in the answers of the risk filter questionnaire, the student must immediately notify the University, the method of reporting the change is to **fill in the questionnaire again.**

4./ I would like to draw your attention to the fact that according to the provision contained in Article 5 Section (2) of the Rector's Instruction:
"In the area of the University, a device to cover the mouth and nose (such as a medical mask, scarf, shawl, hereinafter referred to as "mask"). **is compulsory."**

I respectfully request that you fully comply with the epidemiological hygiene regulations!

I look forward to working with you all to help prevent the spread of the epidemic and protect the health of your fellow students, professors, and staff of the faculty.
