When founding the central-European universities Louis I. of Hungary founded the first Hungarian university in 1367 in Pécs and so the history of Hungarian higher education is accounted for since then. UP celebrated the 650th jubilee of its founding in 2017. In the 20th century a multi-coloured university structure was settled and from 2000, with adjoining most of the higher educational institutes of the South-Transdanubian region, University of Pécs was created, one of Hungary's biggest higher educational

institutes, with around 20000 students. The histo-

The Faculty of Health Sciences is one of the most dynamically developing faculties.

We not only have bachelor programmes but masters as well and we even have our own doctorate school where one can achieve a PhD. The faculty is committed to a lifelong learning and to training high quality professionals in health, social and sport sciences. As the first university level Health Science Faculty of Hungary you can apply to 4 Bachelor and 2 Master programmes.

At the Faculty of Health Sciences you will be able to learn up-to-date, modern, evidence based knowledge of health sciences in nursing, dietetics, physiotherapy or midwifery BSc programmes. The Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) programme - popular and successful throughout the US or the UK - is available from September 2019. Creating a new dimension of nursing, this programme equips you with high level competences – much like physicians -, and you are able to choose from five specializations (anaesthet-

ics, emergency care, gerontology, intensive care and primary care) in which to deepen your knowledge.

From September 2021, you can also start your studies in the Clinical Laboratory Science Master programme.

In accordance with the European Community Law we offer two degrees (nursing, midwifery), which are automatically accepted when applying for a job within the European Union without any necessary licensing procedure.

We have a significant amount of international connections concerning many of the offered programmes so our students have an opportunity to complete part of their studies in one of our partner universities.



PÉCS The city of culture

Pécs is Hungary's fifth most populated cities with around 150 000 citizens. The chief-town of Baranya county, that lays at the foot of Mecsek hills in Southern Transdanubia, with a Mediterranean atmosphere, where the spring is full of flowers, the summer is warm, the autumn is pleasant and the winter is mild.

The history of the city starts 2000 years back in time. The ancient roman city, Sopianae is still used in the names of many institutes or products. In the Middle Ages the city was under Turkish control for over 150 years so today there is more heritage from those ages than in any other Hungarian cities. Even today in the main square stands a Islamic mosque, which is one of the main symbols of Pécs.

The early Christian burial site from the 4th century roman city, Sopianae is on the world heritage list since 2000 and with universal historical value, so is one of the highly important cultural heritage sites for the history of humanity. The city's narrow streets

running up the hills and the tiny squares create a peculiar atmosphere. The downtown area is filled with restaurants where you can sit comfortably on the terrace and enjoy the buzzing life of the city. Another remarkable attraction is the huge cathedral with four towers and the beautiful square in front of it, the remains of the city wall and bastion with restaurants scattered all around the space.

Pécs has one of Hungary's greatest University centres. The first university was founded in the 14th century. The current university has more than 20000 students who make sure that the city is throbbing with life. Within this thriving city are the university faculties located.

Pécs is also known for its prestigious museums, galleries, festivals and other cultural events. The National Theatre of Pécs, the Kodály Centre – resident orchestra: the Pannon Philharmonic orchestra -, the Zsolnay Quarter and the nationwide known ballet company offers interesting programmes, not to mention the Pécs Days, the Zsolnay Light Festival, The Pécs National Theatre Convention, the Pécs City Carnival or the European Winesong Festival.

The region has several sites, attracting tourists: the Mecsek-hills, the Mecsek-Siklós-Villány wine region, the spa in Harkány, the charming old villages of Baranya and the many historical castles in Szigetvár, Siklós, Pécsvárad etc.












SAFETY

NURSING (BACHELOR)

Nursing and Patient Care

In modern health care, due to the application of advanced technologies and the general shortage of physicians the importance of nursing roles has increased. If you want to have a secure job in the EU and would like to care for patients, cure illnesses or are attracted to a comfortable clinical environment, where you can be leader of departments/clinics/hospitals then nursing is for you!

Nurses are in a shortage so there will be no problems with finding working opportunities. It is not common to be unemployed if you hold a degree in nursing and considering the health care professions the amount of the possible income is fairly high. As a nurse (head of department, director), you can settle at any areas of the health care system. The Bachelor of Nursing degree is automatically accepted in the countries of the European Union based on the Community Law of the EU (2005/31). This Bachelor programme has its own Master's programme of 1,5 years which will entitle you to settle in one of the following Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) specializations: anaesthetics, emergency care, gerontology, intensive care and primary care.

This profession requires grave responsibility and deep knowledge of health and natural-medical sciences from the professionals. During the training students get to know the body's normal anatomical and pathological functions, the causes and symptoms of illnesses and the possible treatments and preventions. On the demonstrational exercises the students will be able to practice the medical procedures on lifelike instruments (e.g. blood sampling, infusion therapy, patient examination, punctuation).

DIETETICS (BACHELOR)

Nursing and Patient Care

You are what you eat! May be a commonplace but true nonetheless. Our bodies are highly used by the stressful and fast-paced lifestyle of the 21st century. We especially need to look out for our bodies' signs if we want to meet the challenges of modern society. Do you know what you eat and drink? How much to consume from certain things? What the 'E' numbers are? What fibres are? Why we need antioxidants? By being a nutritionist you will be able to answer these questions: what we should consume, how these certain foods are created, what quality and quantity of ingredients we should use in certain meals. You will be able to propose a nutritional schedule for treating certain illnesses. You will learn that conscious nutrition is more effective than excluding certain foods.

As a nutritionist you will always have a place in working society. Think about it! The number of people affected by lifestyle diseases (e.g. diabetes,

obesity) is growing through the years. You will be able to take many different positions not just the one by the patient's bed: you can work for medicine or food manufacturers, wellness and fitness centres or beside a doctor in medical practice. You can be a food catering manager or you can start your own business as well. In case you want to do research or teach, you can gain a PhD in the doctoral school.

After acquiring the basics of health, life and social sciences you will take part in cooking practices. You will learn the composition of foods from A to Z, so you will understand even the fine print components on the packages of products. After learning the typical diets of certain illnesses you will use this knowledge in practice by working with doctors and your mentors in clinical environment.

PHYSIOTHERAPY (BACHELOR)

Nursing and Patient Care

Let's settle this: a physiotherapist is no masseur or aerobics instructor! Much more than that. The massaging and exercising is only a small element of the wide variety of techniques with which a physiotherapist creates magic: the joy of painless movement. You use your body day to day but have you ever wondered how much work your muscles, sinews and joints do in order to move your body parts in harmony? If you dislocate your ankle or pinch a nerve in your back you will understand how important it is to take good care of your body. With the 20-21st century came a change in our lifestyle. Did you grow up on playing football, climbing trees all day long? These stimuli are important in the early development of our movement and nervous system. As a physiotherapist you can cure the problems created by inactivity.

Although our world is moving fast, we don't move enough. And so a physiotherapist will always have many tasks.

With your creativity and empathy you could be the creator of a new treatment, the new Dévény, McKenzie or Schrott! You don't necessarily have to work in health care; you'll have opportunities to work for wellness, fitness or sport centres, spas and spa-hotels or even sport clubs. If you have the experience you can also start you own business. You can always deepen your knowledge by doing research or teaching: you can gain a PhD in the doctoral school. Or you can open a private physiotherapy praxis.

The health, life and social sciences will be followed by a great deal of anatomy. After mastering these you will deepen your knowledge in the workings of the muscles and joints. You will get the knack of the job after participating in demonstrational practices and if your moves are skilled enough you will then use this knowledge in the field with the help of a mentor.

MIDWIFERY (BACHELOR)

Nursing and Patient Care

Is there anything more moving than watching a mother hold her child for the first time? You can share the moment of the beginning of a new life if you chose one of the eldest professions, midwifery. Being pregnant is fundamentally a natural process. For the health of the mother and the unborn child your help will be essential, especially in childbirth and maternal processes. Not only will you witness the birth of a human being but the birth of a family. You will be the one to help the mother deliver the child but it will be your responsibility to inform a doctor if anything seems amiss. Life is a miracle in itself but it can as easily fade as it can come. You will need to participate in dealing with the pain of loss. It is just as much part of your tasks as bringing joy to the parents.

One thing is for sure: the baby won't stay in the womb forever and until this changes, midwives will be essential to the society.

After you have your certificate you can care for a pregnant mother and conduct a delivery. You will need to support the mother psychologically as well. You will be able to tell when a doctor is needed. Commonly a midwife works in hospitals and other facilities of health and patient care. You can be an assistant in consulting agencies or with acquiring the necessary skills you can start your own practice. The certificate is accepted within the EU as well as in Hungary.

You will learn the foundation of nursery and first aid after mastering basic life (e.g. anatomy) and social (e.g. pedagogy) sciences. By participating in demonstrational practices you will be able to test your skills on lifelike devices. Right after you complete your courses in midwifery and nursing school you will move to a hospital's maternity ward and be under the supervision of a mentor.

ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSE (APRN)

To be highly trained health professional, without losing touch with your caring side.

Treating patients, ordering medication independently? Are you interested but you find the medical school programmes too long? Then the APRN programme is a perfect choice for you.

The APRN provide patient-centred safe and high quality care by partnering with patients and their caregivers. Nurse Practitioners in Hungary will be clinicians with advanced degrees in acute and emergency care areas, and they will be able to do assessments, perform and interpret diagnostics test, set diagnoses as well as prescribe medications and other treatments.

They will blend their clinical expertise with health prevention and health management and deliver a unique blend of nursing and medical care. They will be able to help the patients make healthcare decisions, educate them while treating the whole person. Through their management knowledge, they are able to lead the professional staff and departments and through research methodology and biostatistics knowledge they can organize and execute clinical researches. They may apply their skills into practice in the countries worldwide and in facilities where the legislations, protocols and directives allow that.

Students choose from five specialities: anaesthetics, emergency care, gerontology, intensive care and primary care.

- evaluation of the results of detailed physical patient examinations
- setting up of preliminary diagnosis
- independent compilation of treatment plans
- ordering and analysing of laboratory and imaging tests
- carrying out specialist nursing and patient education tasks
- ordering medication therapy
- modifying and/or supplement medication therapy in the case of chronic conditions
- requesting consultation with physicians in the case of progressive diseases or those with a narrow time window, or critical conditions

- ordering and analysing laboratory and imaging tests
- performing specialist nursing and patient education tasks
- independent implementation a patient-specific plan of care, anaesthetic techniques, selection of anaesthetic medications, including controlled substances and administering them independently
- perform advanced airway management with rapid sequence sedation
- insert invasive and non-invasive monitoring modalities (e.g., central venous access, arterial lines, intraosseale cannula
- needle decompression
- performing invasive procedures (BFS intubation, defibrillation, ALS, cardioversion)

CLINICAL LABORATORY SCIENCE (MASTER)

The aim of the Master's Degree Programme is to train clinical laboratory research professionals who are familiar with the general and specific rules and requirements of clinical laboratory research, and are capable of actively conducting clinical laboratory research in practice. Our aim is to train professionals who are able to conduct, organise and control the clinical trial and evaluation of medical and other therapeutic procedures and diagnostic methods.

Clinical Laboratory Scientists possess the knowledge and skills which makes them capable of getting involved in the development, pre-manufacturing, and the implementation of manufacturing technologies in the field of drugs and laboratory diagnostics. They are qualified to manage clinical laboratory work. They are capable of receiving the newest implications of science and pursuing continuous education, are able to apply their skills in practice in countries and institutions where the relevant laws, directives and protocols allow them. They are prepared to continue their education in doctoral studies.

Minimum application requirements:

- ▶ Bachelor Degree detailed below*
- Intermediate (B2 level) English language proficiency (evaluation based on a Skype interview)
- Eligible medical state (current HIV, Hepatitis B or C, TB (tuberculosis) infections are exclusion criteria at the acceptance)
- * If you have the absolute equivalent Bachelor degree program (Bachelor of Clinical Laboratory Science, Bachelor of Laboratory, Bachelor of Laboratory Science) you can have a direct entry into the program with transferring your credits from the Bachelor into the Master.

Or, you need a minimum of 40 credits from previous studies in: Medical Biochemistry, Clinical Chemistry, Clinical Biochemistry, Molecular Biology, Bioanalitics, Microbiology, Molecular Genetics, Genetics, Cell Biology, Physiology, Cell Physiology, General Pharmacology, Pharmacy, Neurobiology, Neuroanatomy, Cell and Tissue Culture, Animal Testing Knowledge, Histochemistry, Research Management, Hematology and Hemostaseology, Rheology, Flow Cytometry, Microscopic Techniques, Immunology, Toxicology, Mass Spectometry, Separation Techniques, Sampling and Sample Treatment, Laboratory Quality Assurance, Biostatistics. If you don't have the above 40 credits from

If you don't have the above 40 credits from your previous Bachelor studies: under 20 credit points acceptance is not possible, over 20 credits you can enter the program, but have to earn the missing credits at the beginning of the program, as extra courses.
